Below, are 10 summer holiday challenges! We would like you to complete as many of these challenges as possible over your summer holiday break. All students must complete **at least one** challenge, however any student who completes 3 or more, will earn themselves a reward. If you complete all 10, that reward will be substantial!

All the challenges have been designed by your English teachers to widen your experiences and put your English skills into action. You might even have some fun along the way! 2. Write and send a letter to a person which will make a difference.
3. Find out about a famous writer linked to Oxford and teach someone else about them.
4. Spend two hours in your local library and take out two books to read.
5. Make a video arguing a point of view. With permission, upload it onto the internet to share with others.
6. Visit a place of natural or historical interest. Write a travel review about your experience.
7. Research a poem on the topic of conflict and learn the poem off by heart.
8. Read a book that has been made into a film. Discuss with your friends or family which you prefer and why.
9. Look at the headlines of a newspaper and rate the importance of the main stories.
10. Choose a poem or novel of your choice, and re-create it visually.
