Dear Parent and Carer

The Geography Department has organised a fieldtrip to Lulworth Cove, Dorset for Year 7 Geography students on Tuesday 9 July and Friday 12 July. We will be leaving school by coach at 8:00am and returning at 5:30pm.

The aim of the fieldtrip is to look at, and explain, many of the coastal landforms that students study during Year 7 and later on at GCSE level. In addition, students will be assessing the impact of tourism on the area. It is important to stress that although we hope it will be an enjoyable day, students will be expected to work hard and there is a large amount of uphill walking involved throughout the day.

Please check the weather forecast, and if hot, student MUST bring a sun hat and sunscreen with them; if raining students must also bring a waterproof jacket and appropriate clothing, please wear appropriate shoes for coast/countryside walking - staff will not be responsible for providing any such items. Please note that students will require a packed lunch, pen, pencil, and if possible, a clipboard or something similar to lean on. Extra money on the day is not necessary, although there will be an opportunity to buy souvenirs. Full school uniform is not needed.

In order for the fieldtrip to take place, we are requesting a contribution of £18 which includes transport, staff cover and insurance. We are keen that all students be given the opportunity to take part in educational trips and visits, and to that end a 50% contribution towards trip expenses has been made for all Pupil Premium students invited on this trip. Therefore the trip is half price £9 for students who receive the Pupil Premium (PP) as long as the attached slip is completed. If you feel that further financial assistance is needed to enable your child to attend this trip, please contact JGL@cheney.oxon.sch.uk. This amount is non-refundable unless the trip is cancelled by the school. The trip will have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received.

Please give your contribution and consent for the trip via **parentpay** where the trip is entitled 'Lulworth Cove Year 7 2019'. If you do not have parentpay but wish to set up an account please email finance@cheney.oxon.sch.uk or contact Mrs Beesley in the School Shop.
