Teachers have been asked to share the link to the virtual lesson or the uploaded video as an 'assignment' on Show My Homework on the morning of the day the lesson is due to take place. Don't be confused if you see lots of classes in a year group with the same link - this is when a department are running a large session or sharing the same pre-recorded lesson. Parents and carers should be aware that there is no 'waiting room' facility in Google Meets so students may be able to access the chat facility before/after their teacher 'arrives'.
