Year 11 Results Day Information

This year has been particularly complicated and difficult for Year 11. However, we hope that our students will get the outcomes they want this summer. We do not yet know what the social distancing arrangements will be in mid-August, and as such have planned taking into account current social distancing measures.

GCSE results day is on 20 August. We are happy to welcome all students to collect their results envelopes in person from 9:30am in the library around a carefully planned route around the school to accommodate social distancing. Please arrive by 1:00pm at the latest.

We know it is very helpful for students to be able to talk to staff on results day and you can make an appointment to talk to staff safely. Although we encourage students to collect their results in person, we appreciate that it may not be possible. Please use this form

However you receive your results, staff will be available to help and support you with your ongoing plans, on the day we will have an appointment based system to support with social distancing.

The plan for the day will be as follows:

- Register in reception from 9.30am and pick up a destination form
- Walk through to the Library to collect your results
- Head out into Wainwright playground to meet with friends and staff
- Leave via the Attendance gate
 - You will be asked to hand in the completed destination form as you leave.
- Should you wish to speak to a member of staff about your results:
 - A member of staff at the exit gate will support you to make an appointment to meet a member of the Year 11 team/Sixth Form team/careers team/s, or subject teacher/s
 - Appointments will need to be booked and we appreciate your support and patience with ensuring that social distancing is in place at all times.
 - You may be given the opportunity to have a meeting at that time or come back for a meeting at a later part in the day. (You will be required to sign in again at Reception)
