Year 12 Results Day Information

This year has been particularly complicated and difficult for Year 12, but they have done very well during this last term with the wider opening of the school. We know that there is still some anxiety around results day for our Year 12 students who are expecting GCSE Maths and English resit results or BTEC Level 3s. However, we hope that our students will get the outcomes they want this summer. We do not yet know what the social distancing arrangements will be in mid-August, and as such, have planned taking into account current social distancing measures.

At this time we will not be asking Year 12s to come in on Thursday 13 (BTEC) / Thursday 20 August (GCSE Resit) to collect their results. Instead, all students will receive their exam results for any exams which should have been taken in the Summer of 2020 by email, using their school email account. There will be support available for all students in August. Appeals and Autumn Exams
