Firstly, please can I thank those of you who got in touch to give us your feedback on our proposed House system. We had a selection of initial name ideas proposed from our Diversity Group, and parental and student feedback added a number of really exciting suggestions into the mix. We really value the contributions made by our community on what they would like to see embedded in a Cheney House system; the feedback received was constructive and helpful in moving our thinking forward, so thank you to those of you who shared your views.

In total, we were able to canvass the views of students in 75% of our tutor groups, as well as individual feedback from a number of students. Staff were also given opportunity to share their thoughts. From this, the Senior Leadership Team, Diversity Group and our newly appointed Heads of Houses, worked together to choose names that represented the views of the majority of our students. The overwhelming theme to our feedback from students, staff and parents/carers, was that names should attempt to represent the diversity of our school community, and students wanted names that were more global than local.
