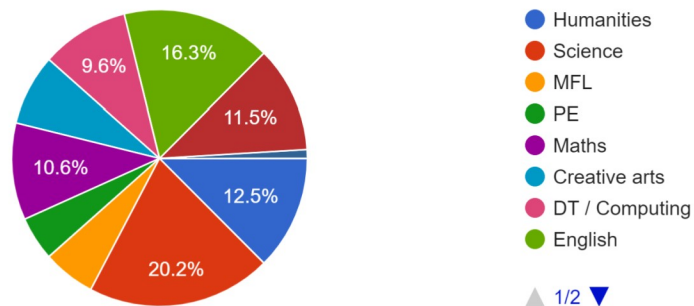

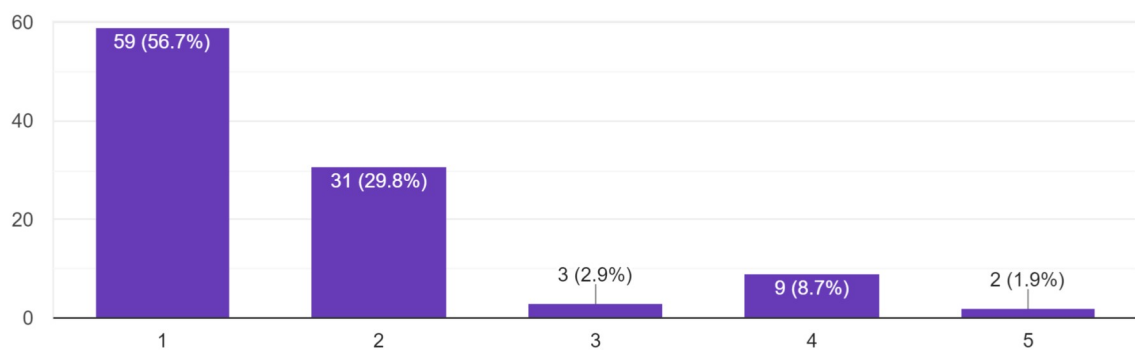

In all of the charts below, 1 = very positive; 5 = very negative

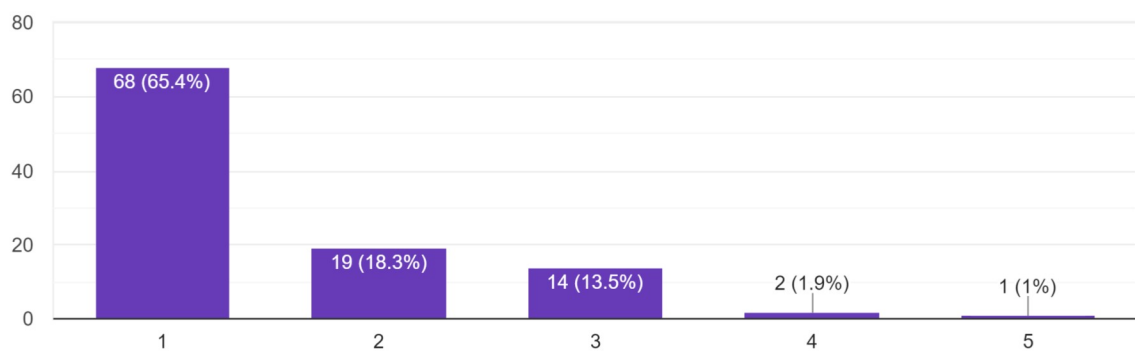
In general, what is your view of returning to specialist rooms?

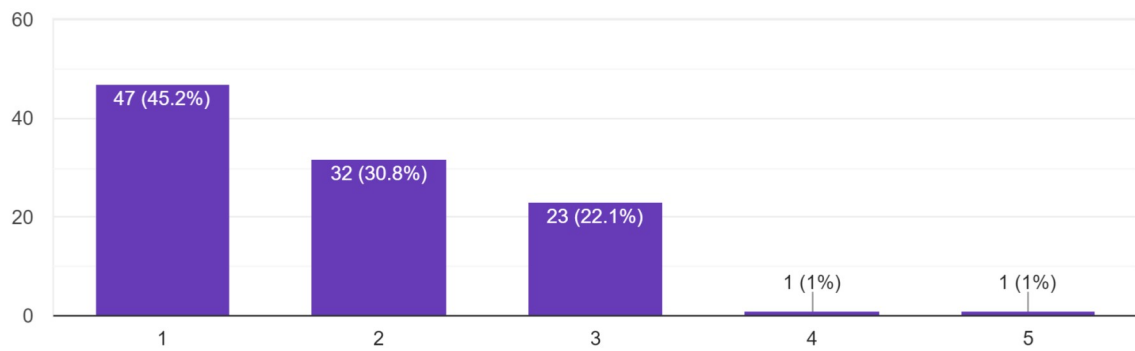
How much easier would it make your life?

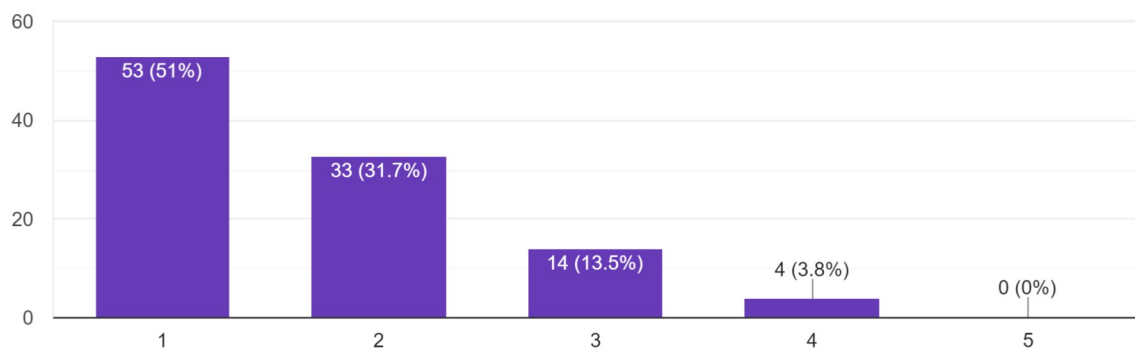
What would the effect on your workload be?

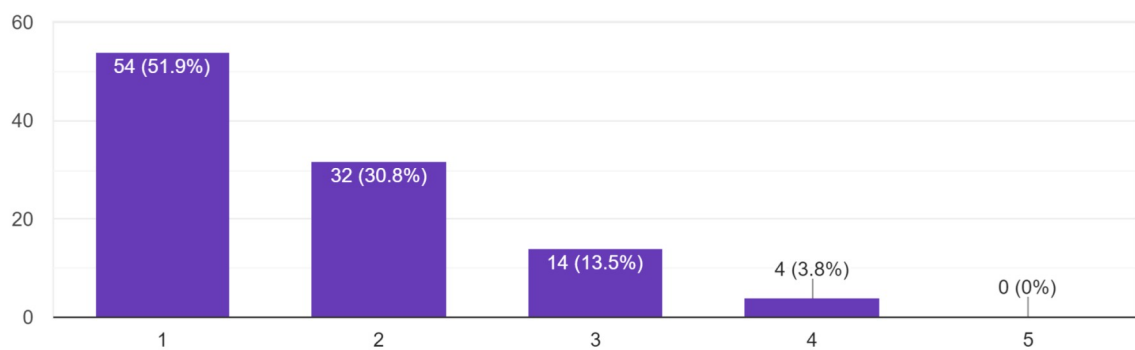
How do you think behaviour would be with teachers in their own rooms?

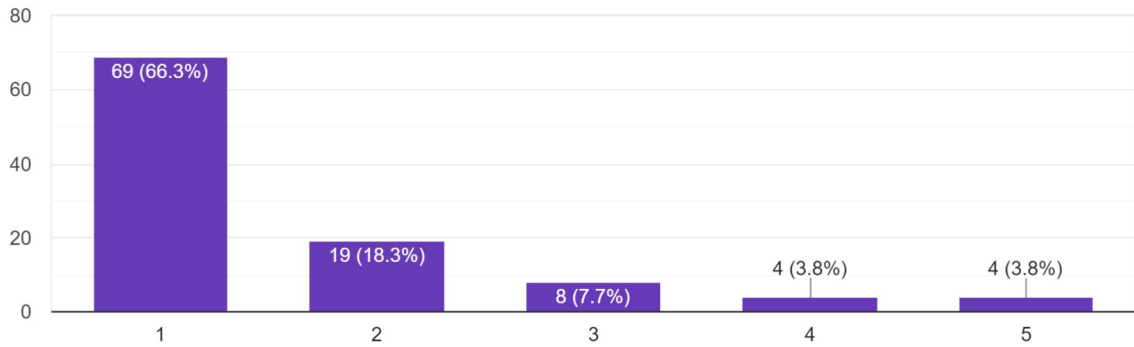
Do you think vulnerable members of staff would be safer or less safe if they could stay out of corridors by having their own room back?

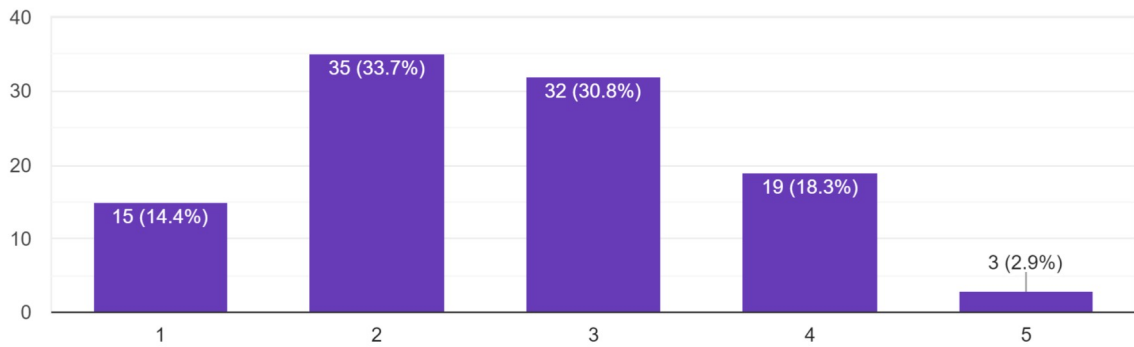
How important is it to you to have specialist rooms available for educational reasons?
