Dear Parents/Carers

Your child is due to receive their HPV vaccination on **Tuesday 23rd February 2021** in school. Due to the current lockdown this vaccination will still go ahead but on an appointment only basis.

Please note, vaccinations can only be offered to children accompanied by a responsible adult, so we ask that parents/carers accompany their child to and from school, unless your child is in school on the day. You will be asked to wait outside whilst your child receives their vaccination.

I will contact you individually with a specific timeslot for your child to come in and receive their vaccination, so please do check your emails regularly; please note that your child will only be allocated a time slot as and when you have completed the online consent form.

As a reminder, the link for the consent form is below. If you have already completed the consent form, you do not need to complete it again.

The unique code for your child's school is: **OX139146**

Please submit your form before **Friday 19 February** to ensure your child receives their immunisation. **The link will close on this date and late consents will not be accepted.**

Do not copy and paste the code as it will not be recognised.

You will need your child's NHS number to complete the form. This is available from your GP practice or can be found in your child's red book.

Please do not attend the appointment and self-isolate immediately if you or your child:

- Have any symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- Have tested positive for coronavirus – this means you have coronavirus live with someone who has symptoms or tested positive
- Someone in your support bubble has symptoms or tested positive
- Are told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace or the NHS COVID-19 app

- Have arrived in the UK from a country with a high coronavirus risk. Please visit www.gov.uk for more information.
- Have travelled from South Africa in the previous 10 days **OR** have had contact with an individual with a travel history to South Africa in the previous 10 days

On Arrival

- Please arrive on time for the appointment (not earlier)
- The vaccinations will take place in the assembly hall. Please head towards the Assembly Hall (enter via the main car park, turn left and the assembly hall is the large building to the left-hand side). There will be signs directing you to the clinic and a member of staff will greet you.
- Please wait outside of the building.
- Please bring your own masks to wear during your appointment.
- Only one person may accompany each child.
- Please be respectful to other building users and maintain a two metre distance from other people whilst waiting for the appointment.

If you or your child are identified as clinically extremely vulnerable and have been shielding, please contact the immunisation team for further advice before attending your appointment.

For children that cannot attend, there will be a catch up date at a later date.
