Appropriate clothing	Sports wear or beach wear, large branded logos nothing offensive
Weather appropriate layers	Outdoor clothing and jackets inside classrooms - or what's appropriate for classroom temperature
Respectful dress	Any clothing you can see up, through or down

Patterns allowed, nothing offensive, t-shirts and collared shirts	Spaghetti straps, crop tops
Jumpers	Hoodies
