
AIM OF THE DESIGN

Our aim is to redesign: 1) the two fenced off seating areas near Chadwick such that they include seating, raised beds and some type of porous paving such that they become less muddy and 2) the quad next to L1 such that it provides covered seating for sixth form students and raised beds to delineate the space.


Greening Cheney - STUDENT MISSION STATEMENT







The submission must include plans, elevations and sections and perspectives showing details of the design. Details of all materials, planting, and furniture should be specified. A design report with an estimate of costs must be submitted. The budget is £100,000 - £50,000 for the L1 quad and £50,000 for the two seating areas.

All entries must reach the school office by 12 noon on Thursday 31/3/2022. The winner will be announced on Friday 30/4/2022.
