**Dear Parents, Carers, Staff, Governors and Year 12 and 13 Students,**

**Bromcom Log-in update:** as mentioned last week, we switch from Arbor to Bromcom on Monday March 21st. Bromcom have Apps for parents, students and teachers, which should be an improvement on what we currently have from Arbor.

The parent app is called MyChildAtSchool, which you can download easily. You will need an invitation code and the school ID. These will be sent by Bromcom, hopefully next week.

There is a student app, which will make checking timetables, House Points and so on much easier. We are getting all students to log into their new emails and transfer content to new Google Classrooms during the day on Tuesday 22 March, and we will have a tutor activity the following week to get students onto the app.

From March 21st, our emails will be changing to the format [ateacher@chensyschool.org](mailto:ateacher@chensyschool.org) although the old addresses will still work for a time, as they will be forwarded to the new accounts.

**Support for Ukraine:** We are working with Oxfordshire County Council to provide support for any children who come into our area and need to register with a school.
