GCSE results day on 25 August from 9:30 and post-results services

We welcome and encourage all students to collect their results envelopes in person from **9:30**. Please arrive by **1:00** PM at the latest.

It is very helpful for students and staff to be able to talk on Results Day, but you can also make arrangements for alternative collection with the [Exam Results Collection Form](#).

However you receive your results, staff will be available to help and support you with your ongoing plans. It is possible to make appointments to speak to a member of staff on the day or the day after and you can request this upon leaving the school.

Due to building works during the summer we are unable to confirm the exact plan for the day. Updated information will be emailed out a few days prior to results day. We do apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Post-results services

The following services are available after results are issued.

- Clerical check - to see if all marks have been added up correctly
- Review of marking - to check if the mark scheme was adhered to
- Access to scripts

Please be aware that there are fees to pay if you wish to apply for a post results service. Services are requested using the [request, consent and payment form](#). The table of fees can be found [here](#) and on the school's website.
